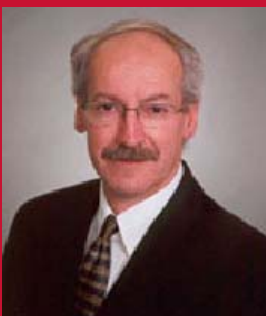

### President's Message

October gave us the third consecutive upswing in trading in CNSX listed securities. The number of trades rose almost 30% while the value of all trades increased by 15% to levels that haven't been seen since May of 2008. The increases are attributable to a cyclical rebound that is now encompassing CNSX small-cap stocks and to the growth in the number of listings on the exchange.

At month end we had 104 companies listed after listing another two new companies during the month. One of these companies was a switch from TSX Venture of a CPC company, Yonge Street Capital. It underwent a reverse takeover with an Indonesian company with over 1,000,000 acres of exploration and production concessions both onshore and offshore Sumatra that the company intends to drill. It recently raised \$2,000,000 to carry out exploration activities.

Another notable listing was Lexaria Corp. This is a Canadian company that has been public in the U.S. but not in Canada and traded on the OTCBB. They are the first company subject to the BCSC policy 51-509, enacted a year ago applying to British Columbia based US OTC issuers, that has filed a non-offering prospectus and listed on CNSX. Lexaria has oil and gas production in Mississippi and exploration activities in Canada and the U.S.

In a continuous drive to improve on our procedures and standards we are introducing modifications to our listing policies. These are contained in a Notice published October 23 reprinted on page 8 of this review.

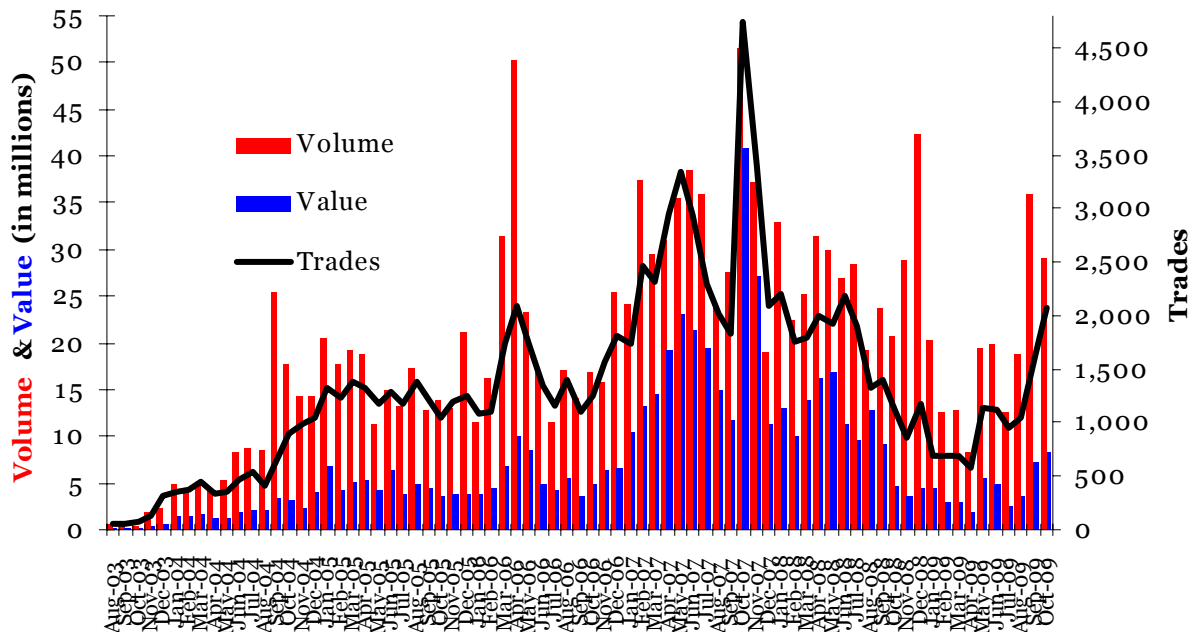

# Pure Trading

Turnover on Pure Trading continued on the upward trajectory we have seen over the last two months. Market share by volume (including crosses) was 1.82% up sharply from September's 1.18%. Continuous auction market trading in October was up almost 2 million shares per day over the previous month. Important volume and market share gains were recorded in stocks trading for both above and below 1 dollar. This activity increase returns Pure Trading to business levels seen in the spring, and is a result not of the arrival of significant new sources of liquidity, but is a result of organic growth in business volumes from our existing customers. We believe that this growth will accelerate with the anticipated arrival of new customers over the next few weeks. One other important trend: for the month we traded slightly more than 1100 of the 1500 names that traded on the "listing market" last month. The daily average number of different stocks trading is well over 600 names, up from 200 only a few months ago. Although some of these issues are of the less liquid variety, Pure Trading is recording national market share of more than 30% in a surprising number of issues.

## Notice 2009-001 Proposed Policy and Rule Changes

### Proposed Policy and Rule Changes – Policy 1, Policy 2, Policy 4, Policy 5 and related forms, and Rule 1-101, Rule 11-102 and Rule 11-103 Notice and Request for Comments

October 23, 2009

The Board of Directors of CNSX Markets Inc. (the “Board”) has passed a resolution to amend Policy 2 – Qualifications for Listing and add new Policy 10 -Specialist Securities as well as to amend Rule 1-101 – Definitions, Rule 11-102 – Qualification for Alternative Market and Rule 11-103 – Access by Eligible Clients to the Alternative Market, subject to Ontario Securities Commission approval, following public notice and comment. Blacklined copies of the proposed amendments to Policy 2, consequential house-keeping amendments to forms 1a, 1b, 2a, 2b and 4, Policies 1, 4 and 5, and the text of new Policy 10 are attached as Appendix A and blacklined copies of the proposed Rule changes are attached as Appendix B.
