Issued June 17, 2010 in Vancouver, British Columbia and distributed through CNW Group.

Item 4 Summary of Material Change

The Company announces that it proposes to consolidate all of its issued and outstanding shares on the basis of 12 “old” common shares for one “new” common share (the “**Consolidation**”); and to change the name of the Company from “Platoro West Holdings Inc.” to “Silver Predator Corp.” in conjunction with the Consolidation.

The Consolidation remains subject to approval by the Canadian National Stock Exchange (“CNSX”). If the Consolidation is approved by CNSX and is subsequently implemented, the number of issued and outstanding common shares of the Company will be reduced to approximately 4,207,250 common shares.

Item 5 Full Description of Material Change

The Company announced that it proposes a consolidation of all of its issued and outstanding shares on the basis of 12 “old” common shares for one “new” common share (the “**Consolidation**”); and to change the name of the Company from “Platoro West Holdings Inc.” to “Silver Predator Corp.” in conjunction with the Consolidation.

Details of the Consolidation were disclosed in the Company’s Management Information Circular dated March 22, 2010, which was filed on the Canadian System for Electronic Document Analysis and Retrieval (SEDAR) and is available for viewing under the Company’s name at www.sedar.com. At the special meeting of the shareholders of the Company held on April 29, 2010, the shareholders passed a special

resolution to amend the articles of the Company so that the directors of the Company may by resolution authorize the consolidation of all or any of its unissued, or fully paid, shares of the Company.

If the Consolidation is approved by the Canadian National Stock Exchange (“CNSX”) and is subsequently implemented, the number of issued and outstanding common shares of the Company will be reduced from 50,486,997 common shares to approximately 4,207,250 common shares. Fractional shares remaining after giving effect to the Consolidation will be cancelled, such that shareholdings of each shareholder will be rounded down to the nearest whole number of post-consolidation common shares.
