The Issuer continues upgrading, field winterization and maintenance work at its East Teapot Project in Wyoming. The Issuer continues searching for acceptable joint venture situations for drilling new wells on both its Montana and Wyoming projects.

Management continued producing oil from the Issuer's East Teapot project in Wyoming. Management finalized a summer work program for its leases in Montana. Results of the work program will determine the most effective plan for production development of the leases.

As announced on 1 June, the Issuer has an initial three well program scheduled for the recently acquired oil leases located in Musselshell, Petroleum and Rosebud Counties Montana.

As mentioned in 3 above, the Issuer will be drilling three wells.
